

Core PE Kit Requirements

At Kibworth Mead Academy, we pride ourselves on offering a broad and balanced Physical Education curriculum that encompasses a variety of different learning opportunities. To support delivery of our curriculum, it is essential that students have suitable PE kit and protective equipment, that will secure both their safety and enjoyment throughout all activities offered. Below details a list of items that students are expected to wear during core PE lessons, including additional personal protective equipment.

Students are expected to have the following items available for PE lessons:

Clothing:

- Long sleeve and/or short sleeve PE top with school logo
- Black sweatshirt with school logo
- Black zip sports jacket with red panelling with school logo
- Black tracksuit bottoms/plain black sports leggings
- Plain black shorts (not tight fitting e.g. Nike Pro or cycling shorts)
- High knee black sport socks (seasonal)

Footwear:

- Sensible footwear (trainers) that offer support and are suitable for practical activity
- 3G appropriate boots e.g. Moulded or screw-in plastic studs. *Spikes, blades, metal studs, flat soled trainers (including dimpled soles) or AstroTurf trainers are not permitted.*

Additional protective equipment:

- Shin pads
- Gum shield
