

Thank you for your interest in the Kibworth Goodman Exhibition Fund. If you are a former or current student of Kibworth Mead Academy/The Kibworth School/Kibworth High School, aged 26 or under, the Fund may be able to help support you with your further education or training.

About the Fund

A former Headmaster of Kibworth Grammar School, Jeremiah Goodman, bequeathed £300 on his death in 1836, in order to found two scholarships for Kibworth boys. In 1880 a Charity Commissioners' Scheme allowed the governors of the school to use the money to provide scholarships for boys leaving for 'places of higher education'. As the school and the education system has evolved over the past two centuries, so has the Fund, and it now offers small 'exhibitions' (grants) to support former students to succeed in their further education or training.

Former students of Kibworth Mead Academy/Kibworth High School/The Kibworth School can apply for grants of up to £150 to support their further education or training. For example, this might include:

- Clothing or materials eg text books or uniform
- Tools or equipment to support educational or training purposes
- Transport/travel costs for educational or training purposes
- Tuition fees for educational or training courses (excludes evening courses)

This list is intended as a guide only and is not exhaustive. Other purposes may be considered if they directly benefit and are essential for the applicant's education or training.

How much funding can be applied for

The fund awards grants of up to £150, dependent on available funds. Successful applicants may only receive one grant each.

When to apply

Applications can be made once each year. **In 2022, the application deadline is 5pm on Monday 10 October 2022.** Late applications will not be considered and will not automatically be carried over to the next application deadline. Late or unsuccessful applicants may re-submit at the next opportunity.

Who can apply

Applicants should be a former student of Kibworth Mead Academy/Kibworth High School/The Kibworth School pursuing further education or training. Applicants must be aged 26 or under. Only one grant per person will be awarded.

How to apply

- Complete and sign the application form.
- Submit your application before the 10 October 2022 deadline to Chair of the Academy Council via the school office at info@kibworth-tmet.uk

Please ensure that you have carefully completed all sections of the application form. Incomplete forms cannot be considered.
- Applications will be reviewed by a panel of the Academy Council once a year within 4 working weeks of the application deadline.
- Successful and unsuccessful applicants will be notified in writing within 30 days of the panel meeting. Please ensure you provide an email address if possible.

Additional notes

- The award of all grants is subject to the availability of sufficient funds in the Goodman Exhibition Trust Fund. The investment is managed by Leicestershire County Council.
- The panel's decision is final. There is no appeals process.
