## What my Year 11 child should be doing now

Students should be in the process of writing their personal statements and will have an opportunity over the next two weeks in tutor time to finalise a first draft. The first draft should be completed by **Friday 14**<sup>th</sup> **October 2022.** 



All Year 11 students are in the process of having a 1:1 careers talk for 30 mins with Cheryl McCarthy (Careers Practitioner from LifeJigsaw), where she will offer advice and guidance about post 16 choices. These have started and will be running throughout September and October.

Educational Trust

Students will apply to most courses through Positive Steps (PS) 16. Students will be given a username and password for this and how to apply. The deadline for students to have applied to colleges will be December 12<sup>th</sup>. Please do not make your own PS16 account as it is more difficult to track and provide a reference.

Students should ensure they are completing homework set to a good standard and actively revising for any mini assessments set. This will support them in the build up to longer revision periods in advance of the autumn term **pre public exams (mocks)** that will take place from **Monday 31**<sup>st</sup> **October** and last approximately two weeks.
