How can I help support my child revise for GCSE French/ Spanish?

Having a wide and varied vocabulary is essential if your child is to succeed and will enable them to achieve in all 4 skills.

You can encourage them to revise vocabulary using:





• Your child will have vocabulary set on Quizlet as part of their homework each week and will be tested on this vocabulary, but they can also recap and revise vocabulary from previous topics and use the vocabulary sets to make revision/flash cards to revise at any point.







Lots of different films and TV shows in French and Spanish - watch them in French and Spanish with subtitles - good for extra listening practice.

Duolingo is a great way to learn new words and to keep up with regular practise each day



- You could test your child on some of the vocabulary they have learnt each week, using any flashcards they have produced, or ask them to teach you some new words.
- Encourage them to come along to after-school revision sessions.
- Visit the AQA website to access past papers
- Download the specification vocabulary and help them to learn as much of it as they can

- Use the BBC Bitesize website to revise different topics
- Practise writing answers to longer questions and hand it to their teacher to mark
- Encourage them to attend 121 drop in sessions for support on anything they are struggling with.
